



## CONNECT GROUP GUIDE

### Connect Group Guide: WK 25 “The Whole Story” Who is Jesus?

#### Opening

Begin by reading Matthew 1:18–25 together.

Ask someone to summarize the sermon in 2–3 sentences: *What stood out? What challenged you? What made you think differently about Jesus?*

#### Discussion Questions:

1. “Who do YOU say that I am?” — Jesus’ question to Peter
  - When you think about Jesus right now, not what you’ve been taught your whole life... Who is Jesus to *you*? Is He LORD? Savior? Helper? Distant? Close? Optional? Everything?
  - Matthew introduces Jesus as Christ (which means King/Lord).
  - In what areas of your life is Jesus truly LORD—meaning He gets the final say?
  - In what areas do you honestly still function as your own boss? (Be real: habits, relationships, money, decisions, priorities, identity, control.)
2. “God. With. Us.” — How do you really view His presence?  
Jesus is IMMANUEL.
  - When life gets hard, which view describes you more?
  - – God WITH me
  - – God AGAINST me
  - – God is DISAPPOINTED in me
  - – God is DISTANT from me
  - Why do you think you see Him that way?
3. Jesus stepped into our mess — Do you let Him into yours?
  - Jesus came to be with US—broken, sinful, imperfect people. Which is harder for you to believe?:
    - a. “I’m not too bad to need saving,”
    - b. “I’m not too broken to be saved”?
  - How do those beliefs shape the way you relate to Jesus?
4. Savior — What do you *really* think you need saving from?
  - Everyone tries to be their own savior (which is really just religion): good works, avoiding sin, being nice, fixing themselves.
  - In your honest moments, what do you still try to “save yourself” from instead of trusting Jesus?
  - What would it look like to fully trust Jesus as your Savior this week?





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5. Identity Check — If Jesus is King, what changes?
  - If Jesus is really:
    - The Christ (King)
    - Son of David (the True Ruler)
    - God with Us (present)
    - Savior (Rescuer)
  - How would your life look different tomorrow if you believed all of that 100%?
  - Name one specific change.
6. “God with US” — Who is “us”?
  - Jesus came to be with ordinary, messy people.
  - Who in your life needs to experience “God with them” through you this week?
  - What is one practical way you can show them Jesus?
7. “Now What?” — Response Matters
  - After reading Matthew 1:18–25, what is the Holy Spirit nudging you to do next? Is it trust? Repentance? Obedience? Letting go? Asking forgiveness? Surrendering control?
  - When you think about Jesus—who He is and what He’s done—what emotion rises in you? Gratitude? Fear? Distance? Love? Shame? Joy? Why do you think that emotion comes up?

#### **Group Prayer Time**

Close by praying over two things: (Encourage members to pray short, honest prayers—not long paragraphs)

- “Jesus, show us who You really are.”
- “Help us respond to You with trust, surrender, and obedience.”
