Connect Group Guide: WK 33 TWS: Whose Boat Are you In

Big Idea: Faith in Jesus brings peace—not because storms stop, but because Jesus is with us and will get us to the other side.

Read: Mark 4:35–41, then Mark 5:1–2.

Discussion Questions:

1. What stands out to you most in this passage?
2. The disciples were in the boat with Jesus, while others were just around Him (v.36). What's the difference between being around Jesus and truly being with Him?
3. When life gets chaotic, what usually tells you whether Jesus is truly the “captain” of your life—peace or panic? Why?
4. Jesus doesn't stop the storm immediately, but He is present in it. How does this shape the way we think about God's sovereignty and suffering?
5. The Bible shows storms come in different ways—some we cause, some are spiritual, and some are allowed by God. Why do you think God can still use all of them for our Good and His Glory?
6. Rick Warren said, “Your greatest ministry will likely come from your deepest pain.” How have you seen a storm in your life become part of your story—or help someone else trust Jesus?
7. Mark 5:1–2 shows they actually made it to the other side. How does this point us to the promise that Jesus finishes what He starts in us—not just in this life, but into eternity?
8. Based off this passage- What is your Next Step?
