READ TOGETHER

Genesis 12:1–5 Genesis 15:1–6 Genesis 17:1–7 Genesis 21:1–7

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Grace Before Greatness: "God's choice of Abraham wasn't about Abraham's greatness—it was about God's grace."
 - How would you describe grace?
 - Why is it significant that the Bible never says Abraham was righteous before God called him?
 - How does God's grace give us hope, even when we feel unqualified or unworthy?
- 2. Faith in Action: "Abraham's faith wasn't perfect—but it was active."
 - How would you describe faith?
- How does Abraham show us that true faith involves action?
- Read James 2:17. What does this verse teach about the connection between faith and obedience?
- Where is God calling you to take a step of faith, even if it doesn't make sense?\
- 3. Obedience That Costs: "Obedience doesn't always make sense, isn't always comfortable, and often takes patience."
 - Can you relate to a time when obeying God was costly, uncomfortable, or unclear?
 - What keeps us from obeying God fully?
 - How do Abraham's failures (taking Lot, lying about Sarah, Hagar & Ishmael) remind us of our own struggles with partial obedience?
- 4. God's Faithfulness Despite Our Failures: "Even in our unfaithfulness, God remains faithful."
- Read Genesis 18:14. Why is this question so important: "Is anything too hard for the Lord?"
- How does Abraham's story show that our failures don't cancel God's plans?
- How does this encourage you in your own walk with God?
