



**WK 13 STARTING POINT
1 JOHN 5:13-21**

CELEBRATE:

Share a “God moment” from your week. Big or small—how did you see Him move? (Answered prayer, unexpected peace, a chance to love someone, etc.)

READ TOGETHER: 1 John 5:13–21

BIG IDEA:

God isn’t demanding something from us—He’s offering us something amazing. John closes this letter by showing what God wants FOR His children:

- Assurance of Salvation (v13)
- Relationship with Him (v13-15)
- Confidence in Prayer (14-15)
- Victory over Sin (v18–19)
- Intimacy with Jesus (v20)
- Life under His Lordship (free from idols) (v21)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What does it mean to have assurance of your salvation? (v13)
2. How would you describe your relationship with God right now—distant, close, or somewhere in between?
3. According to verses 14–15, how does knowing God’s will affect how we pray?
4. Which of the 6 things God wants for you stood out most—and why?
 - Assurance
 - Relationship
 - Confidence in Prayer
 - Victory over Sin
 - Intimacy with Jesus
 - Living under His Lordship
1. How does it change your view of God when you realize He wants good things for you, not just things from you?
2. Are there any “idols” in your life—things you’re tempted to love, trust, or follow more than Jesus?
3. Who are you praying for that’s far from God? How can your group pray with you for them?
4. What’s your next step? Which area are you not fully living in yet?

PRAY TOGETHER;

- Thank God for what He wants for you—assurance, freedom, relationship.
- Confess anything that’s competing for your heart (idols, distractions, sins).
- Ask Him to grow your love for Jesus and help you walk in freedom.
- Pray for specific people who need salvation or healing.

CLOSING CHALLENGE:

“God doesn’t want to be at the top of your list. He wants to be THE list.” This week, live in a way that shows Jesus is not just part of your life—He is your life.
