

WK 4 Cultures of a Healthy Church-Generosity

Icebreaker:

- When was a time someone showed you unexpected generosity?
- How did it make you feel?

Read Together:

Matthew 6:19–24 Mark 12:41–44 Romans 5:8

Discussion Questions:

Heart Check:

- 1. Jesus said, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
- 2. What do you think your bank statement would reveal about your priorities?
- 3. What things (besides money) tend to compete with God for your heart?
- 4. According to Jesus in verse 24, why can't we serve both God and money?
- 5. What are some signs that money is becoming a master rather than a servant?
- 6. How would you define generosity in your own words?
- 7. What do you think makes someone truly generous?

Jesus as Our Model:

- 1. The sermon emphasized that people who follow Jesus do what Jesus did.
- 2. How was Jesus radically generous with His life and resources?
- 3. Read Romans 5:8 "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
- 4. How does God's generosity through Jesus challenge or encourage you to live differently?

Where Do You Land?

- 1. The sermon mentioned two common responses:
 - a. "If I had more, then I'd be generous."
 - b. "I'm generous enough already."
 - c. Which mindset do you identify with more right now—and why?
- 2. In Mark 12:41–44, Jesus commends the widow who gave out of her poverty.
 - a. What does this teach us about the heart behind giving?

Application & Next Steps

Examine

• What's one thing in your life that might be hindering you from being more generous—money habits, fear, lifestyle choices, etc.?

Take a Step

- What's a practical step you can take this week toward generosity?
 - Start tithing or giving regularly
 - Increase your giving
 - Give time or talents (serving, mentoring, hospitality) "Generosity starts in the heart, not the bank account."

Trust God

- Read Luke 12:48: "From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded."
 - In what area of your life do you need to trust God more with what He's given you?
