



Connect Group Guide: WK 2 Home Wreckers: Pride & Selfishness

READ: James 4:1-6, Phil 2:1-11

1. In what areas of your life do pride and selfish ambition show up most clearly, and how are those things competing with your trust in Jesus?
2. James says our quarrels come from desires battling within us. What desires are currently controlling your heart more than your desire to glorify Christ?
3. How does the humility of Jesus in Philippians 2 challenge the way you approach your home, marriage, friendships, work, or church relationships?
4. Where are you more concerned with protecting your image than reflecting Jesus to the people around you?
5. Jesus “made Himself nothing” and became a servant for us. What would it look like for you this week to intentionally lay down your comfort, preferences, or pride in order to serve someone else?
6. The sermon points out that comparison fuels pride and insecurity. How has comparing yourself to others affected your joy, contentment, or obedience to God?
7. The gospel reminds us that Jesus humbled Himself all the way to the cross to save sinners like us. How should His grace toward you shape the way you respond when your pride is exposed or corrected?

Deeper Theological Questions

1. Why do you think pride is so offensive to God according to Scripture, and how does the humility of Christ reveal the true character of God?
2. Philippians 2 shows that Jesus willingly laid aside His rights and privileges to serve and save others. What does this teach us about true greatness in the kingdom of God versus greatness according to the world?
